As a follow-up to our recent legislative grant workshops, we are pleased to inform you that the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board's (PLCB) Bureau of Alcohol Education 2009/2010 grant process is officially open. Funding is available to all colleges, universities, municipalities, school districts, and community groups throughout the Commonwealth to help reduce and eliminate underage and dangerous use of alcohol. The maximum award is \$11,500.00 and only one grant application per entity is permitted. The deadline for submission is February 26, 2009 at 4 P.M.

In these trying economic times, we are well aware of the number of funding requests your office receives from various organizations throughout the year. The PLCB is able to assist organizations in combating underage and dangerous drinking in their community.
